

# sowing and growing Eucalyptus spp.



## Sowing

Germination: 14–21 days at 18–24°C Sow into cell trays of potting mix 14 weeks before last frost. Cover lightly with fine vermiculite. Bottom water.



## Transplanting

Seedlings may need to be potted up. Harden off. Transplant outside into well-drained, fertile soil with worm castings, after last frost. Space 12-24" in full sun.



### Growing

Water as needed (don't overwater)! Healthy soil won't require additional fertilizer. May be grown as a perennial if overwintered in a heated greenhouse or home.



#### Harvesting

Harvest once the leaves start to feel leathery. Can be used dry or fresh as flower foliage. Enjoy the fragrance!
