



SOWING AND GROWING

Eucalyptus spp.



Sowing

Germination: 14-21 days at 18-24°C

Sow into cell trays of potting mix 14 weeks before last frost. Cover lightly with fine vermiculite. Bottom water.



Transplanting

Seedlings may need to be potted up. Harden off. Transplant outside into well-drained, fertile soil with worm castings, after last frost. Space 12-24" in full sun.



Growing

Water as needed (don't overwater)! Healthy soil won't require additional fertilizer. May be grown as a perennial if overwintered in a heated greenhouse or home.



Harvesting

Harvest once the leaves start to feel leathery. Can be used dry or fresh as flower foliage. Enjoy the fragrance!
